The private association Kunstraum München was founded in 1973 on the initiative of Michael Tacke. Honorary director was Herman Kern. After his death in 1985 Christine and Michael Tacke took over on a voluntary basis. Between 1973 and 1995 the Kunstraum organized 120 exhibitions with 100 artists. For each exhibition they published a catalog and exclusive editions. The first location was in the Nikolaistraße. 1990 the Kunstraum moved to new premises in the Viktor-Scheffel-Strasse. On the occasion of 20th anniversary in 1993 the Kunstraum published exclusive editions by the following artists:
